PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING – BERRYLANDS ROAD AREA, MORETON

Following a report submitted to the Council's Streetscene and Transport Services Overview & Scrutiny Committee, a recommendation has been made to introduce a 20 miles per hour zone in the following roads: Maryland Lane, Harvest Lane, Berrylands Road, Berrylands Close, Bramble Way, Meadfoot Road, Flaxhill, Heathmoor Road, Lingham Lane, Lingham Close, Eleanor Road, Glasier Road and Bradman Road.



The proposed scheme requires the construction of 20 No. bituminous round-topped road humps and 10 No. Mastic Asphalt speed cushions, the locations of which are shown on the attached Schedule.

Associated skid-resistant surface treatment and traffic signing will accompany these works.

A plan of the scheme can be viewed at Moreton Library, Pasture Road, Moreton, Wirral.

Please contact Streetscene on telephone number 0151-606-2004 if you wish to discuss the scheme at any time. However, before you do telephone, please consider the following frequently asked questions:

- Q.** Why do we need traffic-calming and a 20 mph zone?
A. To reduce vehicle speeds and help create a safer environment.
- Q.** Will I be able to park my vehicle on any of the road humps?
A. Yes, however that is provided that by doing so your vehicle does not cause a hazard to other road users or pedestrians.

PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS

BERRYLANDS ROAD AREA, MORETON

Notice is hereby given that Wirral Borough Council propose to construct road humps in the Berrylands Road Area, Moreton, as authorised by Section 90A of the Highways Act, 1980.

It is proposed install 20 no. bituminous round topped round humps and 10 mastic asphalt speed cushions. The round-topped road humps are to be 3.7m long and are to stretch across the width of the carriageway terminating approximately 200mm from each kerb line. The flat topped cushions are to be 3.5m long and 1.6m wide and will be constructed in sets of two across the width of the carriageway. The humps and cushions will have a nominal height of 75mm. The locations of the humps are as follows:-

- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 1/3 Harvest Lane.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 9 and 14/16 Harvest Lane.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 23/25 and 34/36 Harvest Lane.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 31/33 and 54/56 Harvest Lane.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 43 and 74/76 Harvest Lane.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 61 and 90/92 Harvest Lane.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 1/3 and 2/4 Flaxhill.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 19/21 and 18/20 Flaxhill.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 25/27 and 24/26 Heathmoor Road.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 1/3 and Newholme Berrylands Road.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 19 and 20a/20 Berrylands Road.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 25c/27 and 22/24 Berrylands Road.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 41/43 Berrylands Road and side of 23 Bramble Way.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 50/52 and 55 Berrylands Road.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 70/72 and 69/71 Berrylands Road.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 79/81 and 86/88 Berrylands Road.
- 1 no. hump in the vicinity of 99/101 and 114/116 Berrylands Road.
- 2 no. cushions in the vicinity of 2 and 3 Lingham Lane.
- 2 no. cushions in Lingham Lane, side of 2 Eleanor Road.
- 2 no. cushions in the vicinity of 26/28 and 23 Lingham Lane, side of 1 Glasier Road.

1 no. hump in the vicinity of 35 Lingham Lane and side of 27 Lingham Close.

1 no. hump in the vicinity of 1 and 4 Eleanor Road.

2 no. cushions in the vicinity of 1/5 and 2/4 Glasier Road.

2 no. cushions in the vicinity of 18 and 21 Glasier Road.

1 no. hump in the vicinity of 3 and 6 Bradman Road.

A plan of the scheme may be seen at the Town Hall, Wallasey (ref: BGE), and at Moreton Library, Pasture Road, Moreton Wirral.

Any objections to the proposal together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 8 October 2008.
